We have audited the financial statement relating to the Event known as "Elements Campaign" held by the Company from 1 November 2013 to 1 January 2014 set out on pages 3 to 5, which comprise the statement of comprehensive income and expenditure for the period from 1 November 2013 to 1 January 2014, and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory notes.



**NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENT**

**1. GENERAL INFORMATION**

Art In Hospital Limited is incorporated in Hong Kong and limited by guarantee.

The address of its registered office is Room 303, 3/F, 2 Harbour Road, Wanchai, Hong Kong.

Every member of the Company undertakes to contribute to the assets of the Company in the event of the same being wound up while he or she is a member or within one year afterwards, for payment of the debts and liabilities of the Company contracted before he or she ceases to be a member and of the costs, charges and expenses of winding up, and for the adjustment of the rights of the contributories amongst themselves, such amount as may be required not exceeding HK\$100.

The principal activity of the Company is engaged in fund raising to provide services to the hospitalized patients and medical staff by bringing art into the environment of hospitals or other similar establishment. The Elements Campaign is an event organized by the Company for the purpose of raising charitable funds for operating cost for the Company.

This financial statement is presented in units of Hong Kong Dollars (HK\$), unless otherwise stated. This financial statement has been approved for issue by the Board of Councillors on 2 April 2014.

**2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

**(a) Basis of preparation**

The principal accounting policies adopted in the preparation of this financial statement is set out below. These policies have been consistently applied to all the period presented, unless otherwise stated.

The financial statement has been prepared in accordance with new and revised Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standards (“HKFRSs”), Hong Kong Accounting Standards (“HKASs”) and Interpretations (“HK (SIC)-Ints”) (collectively the “new HKFRSs”) issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants. They have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

**2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (continued)**

**(b) Revenue and expenditure recognition**

Provided it is probable that the economic benefit will flow to or from the Company and the income and expenditure, if applicable, can be measured reliably, income and expenditure is recognised in the statement of comprehensive income and expenditure as follows:

- (i) Donations received from fund raising activities are recognised in the accounts on cash basis and includes all sums received up to the reporting period.
- (ii) Expenditure are recognised on accrual basis.

**(c) Taxation**

The Company is exempted under Section 88 of the Inland Revenue Ordinance from any tax levied in Hong Kong by reason of being a charitable institution.
